1992 PRELIMINARY DATA (JANUARY)

Total merchandise trade for the first month of 1992, at US\$210.0 million, was comprised of imports, US\$130.1 million, and exports, US\$79.9 million. When compared with the corresponding month of 1991, imports fell by US\$8.8 million or by 6.3 percent. However there was a US\$8.2 million or 11.4 percent growth in estimated export earnings. The balance of trade at the beginning of 1992 therefore stood at -US\$50.2 million compared to -US\$67.1 million at the beginning of 1991. This represents a 25.2 percent improvement in the trade deficit in January 1992 over January 1991.

All categories of imports using the END-USE classification, showed a fall in January 1992 when compared with January 1991. Consumer goods at US\$22.8 million was down 4.6 percent, raw material imports at US\$86.4 million declined by 5.1 percent and capital goods imports at US\$86.4 million fell by 21.7 percent. Imports in all SITC sections, other than 'Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles' (which went up 8.5 percent), were at a lower level in January 1992 compared to a year earlier. The growth in export earnings in January 1992 over January 1991 was due primarily to a US\$8.0 million rise in 'Food' exports.

CARICOM

The value of imports from Caricom in January 1992 was up marginally over the corresponding month of 1991. An estimated US\$6.5 million was imported from Caricom partners. This was 1.9 percent above the US\$6.4 million imported in January 1991. Export earnings at US\$3.0 million fell by 18.9 percent in January 1992.
