BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade Union (Amendment) Short title Act, 1998 and shall be read and construed as one with the struction. Trade Union Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.
